To request a letter of support please allow a minimum of 5 business day to give the executive committee time to review, approve, and draft the letter.

Information that should be included with your request include the funding announcement and project titles and sources (CDC, HRSA, ACS, etc.), the project priorities and activities, and a contact person. If you have the ability to provide a bulleted list or a draft letter for the executive committee to work from. You can email your request with all of the above information to ndcc@nd.gov.
