



Each year over 4,300 North Dakota residents are diagnosed with a new cancer and over 1,300 will die from the disease. In 2001 the North Dakota Cancer Coalition (NDCC) was founded to assist in the development of a statewide cancer control plan. The first grant was received in 2003, and the first cancer control plan was launched in 2006. The NDCC collaborates with the state's Comprehensive Cancer Control Program to continuing moving the objectives and strategies identified in the statewide cancer control plan forward.

A cancer-free future in North Dakota



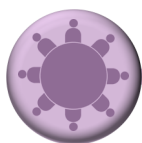
MISSION
